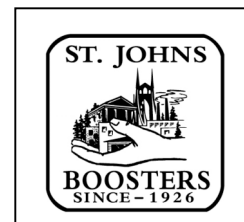

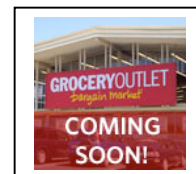
## HAPPY FEBRUARY EVERYONE!

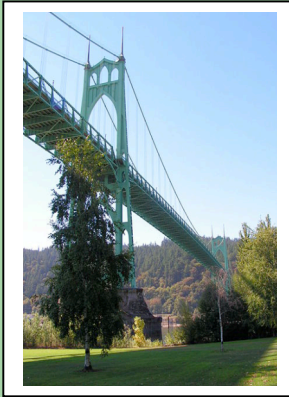
### INDEPENDENT STORE OPERATORS

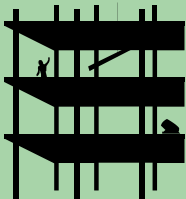

### ***VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES***

ON **MARCH 30** WE ARE STARTING THE ST. JOHNS MAIN STREET FOOT PATROL. WITH THE BLESSING OF THE OLD GUARD WE ARE HOLDING A TRAINING WITH THE HOPES OF BRINGING A NEW GENERATION OF SAFETY TO ST. JOHNS. THE TRAINING WILL BE AT THE ST. JOHNS MAIN STREET OFFICE, 8250 N. LOMBARD (DOOR IS ON N. CHARLESTON ST.) FROM 6:30-9PM WEDNESDAY, MARCH 30. ANY MERCHANT OR NEIGHBOR WHO WANTS TO HEAR ABOUT THE FOOT PATROL PLEASE COME. OUR HOPE IS THAT BY THE END OF THE EVENING WE WILL HAVE COMMITMENTS FROM THE ATTENDEES TO BEGIN WALKING IMMEDIATELY IN APRIL. THE COMMITMENT WILL BE FOR EACH PERSON TO WALK ONCE A MONTH, AND YOU WILL HAVE A CHOICE OF YOUR SHIFT.
