Goodbye 2010, the past year was full of activity for the St Johns Boosters.

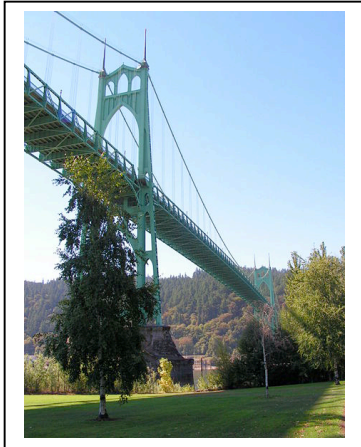
